Inter-Agency Video Montage Contest

I. BACKGROUND:

The National Statistics Month (NSM) was first observed in 1990 pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647 signed by then President Corazon C. Aquino on September 20, 1990, Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month.

The DOLE Regional Office No. X (DOLE-X) in coordination with the Philippine Statistics Authority X will be hosting the 32nd National Statistics Month with the theme "NSM@32: Revving up for Economic and Social Recovery through Evidence-Based Policies".

Pursuant to DOLE Administrative Order No. 92 Series of 2021 entitled the DOLE Committee for Hosting of the 32nd National Statistics Month and in support to Regional Development Council X Resolution No. 60 Series of 2021 entitled Supporting the National Statistics Month Celebration in October 2021, the DOLE X will be conducting the Virtual Data Festival for the month of October and will be sponsoring the Inter-Agency Video Montage Contest.

Montage is a technique of film editing that combines a series of short shots or clips into one sequence, often set to music. The word montage is French for "assembly" or "editing."

II. OBJECTIVES:

Inter-Agency Video Montage is a no dialogue digital video montage competition that aims to:

- 1. To showcase the data and statistics of each agency for public information.
- 2. To promote, enhance, and instill awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society;
- 3. To elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standards of statistics in the country.

III. CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS:

A. Eligibility:

- 1. The Inter-Agency Video Montage Contest is open to All Regional Line Agencies and/or Provincial Field Offices in Region X.
- 2. Video Montage must be original and not have been submitted in any other competition and must be made particularly for the Virtual Data Festival Inter-Agency Video Montage Contest.

B. Guidelines:

- 1. Entries must be in the form of video montage depicting public advocacy showcasing the data and statistics of their agency and should be in line with the 32nd NSM Theme: "NSM @ 32: Revving up for Economic and Social Recovery Through Evidence-Based Policies";
- 2. Each entry must focus on topics relating to vital statistical information, concern or challenge as it gears to labor market information, population growth, health, education, agriculture, among others;
- 3. Voice overs are allowed.

- 4. Entries must have a running time of minimum of 60 seconds or one (1) minute and a maximum of 120 seconds or two (2) minutes, excluding a maximum of 10 seconds for end credits;
- 5. Music, photos used in the videos must have no issues with regards to licenses and such;
- 6. Upon submission, RSC X and DOLE X maintains the right to reproduce, reprint, distribute, perform, display, or exhibit the project for advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes on their website, at conferences, or at any other venues particularly in DOLE Labor and Employment Education Services (LEES) under the Labor Education Program (LEP);
- 7. List of minor and major awards will have one (1) winner (Award descriptions and criteria listed below);
- 8. Participating agencies must send their entries in mp4 format to dole10.ord@gmail.com and should be submitted not later than October 15, 2021, Friday 5:00 PM. Entries received beyond the set deadline will be automatically disqualified.
- 9. Entries to be submitted shall include the following:

C. Prizes:

Minor award winners will receive Certificate of Recognition and Major award winners will receive Certificate of Recognition and Cash prizes.
