The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) – Mindanao Regions invite the students of the colleges and universities in Mindanao to participate in the StaTiktok Contest of the 2024 RDaFest – Mindanao Cluster.

About the StaTiktok Contest

StaTiktok Contest is a video-making contest with a goal to create **short**, **creative**, **and informative video** related to the theme "Harnessing the Power of Data and Statistics for Future-ready Filipino and Filipina Youth" of the 2024 Regional Data Festival (Mindanao Cluster). The videos may also include commentary or narration to provide additional context and insights related to the abovementioned theme. The Tiktok video entry is intended to make statistics interesting and accessible to a wider audience.

StaTiktok Contest is open to all currently enrolled college students. Entries can be from an individual, pair, or group of students with no limit on the number of members. A college or university can send only **one entry**.

Submission of Entries

Please note that the Tiktok link and the video file should be provided by the participant in the Google submission.

Guidelines

- The StaTiktok entry must be officially endorsed by the college or university. The endorsement must contain information on the names of the participating students with their corresponding courses.
- The entry must be aligned with the theme of the Regional Data Festival, "Harnessing the Power of Data and Statistics for a Future-ready Filipino and Filipina Youth".
- The submitted entry must be an original work, has not been submitted to any other competition, has not been used for commercial or publicity purposes, and does not infringe on any third party's existing copyrights.
- Entries can be in Filipino, English, or a combination of both. Entries may also use any dialect but should include subtitles.
- For additional context, insights, and emphasis on the theme, the entry can have creative elements such as voice overs, texts, and photos, and it may also feature individuals or group who have given their consent on their exposure. However, inclusion of clips from other sources/materials are not allowed. Entries with improper or indecent content will be outright excluded.
- The StaTiktok entry must be at least 1 minute and not more than 3 minutes in video duration.
- The entry must be posted through one of the contestant's Tiktok account with hashtag, #mindanaodatafest. Note that the contestant's account should be set as public so that everyone can view the StaTiktok entry, including the judges.
- An initial screening of the entries will be conducted. The contestants will be notified through email whether the submitted entries passed or failed the initial screening.
- All entries which passed the initial screening will be uploaded in the official Facebook pages of the PSA Mindanao regions. Once the selected entries are uploaded in the PSA Mindanao regions official Facebook page, the Data Fest Secretariat will notify the submitting entities for them to share their entries to gain likes, reactions, and shares.
- The aggregated number of likes, reactions, and shares gained from all Facebook pages will be the basis for the "Engagement" criteria.
- Submission of an entry to the PSA shall be deemed as a consent for the PSA to use such entry for advocacy purposes and/or any other uses as it may deem appropriate.
- The Board of Judges reserves the right to disqualify any submitted entry that does not comply with the mechanics or has concerns about copyright infringement.
- The top three entries will be chosen as winners and will receive plaques and tokens.
- The winners will be announced during the Closing Ceremony of the 2024 Regional Data Festival (Mindanao Cluster).

Criteria for Judging

The Tiktok video has made its impact by promoting statistics/statistical activities to the general public through the use of Facebook reactions and shares. The aggregated number of likes, reactions, and shares gained from Facebook will be the basis for this criterion.

The entry shows creative standards such as originality, storytelling, visual impact, entertainment value, and retention which effectively engage the

viewers to convey the message and leave a lasting impression.
