PSA X Supports the Launching of eGovPH App and eLGU Kickoff

On 26 February 2025, the Multipurpose Hall of the New Provincial Capitol in Mambajao, Camiguin became the center of a significant milestone in the province's digital transformation. The Philippine Statistics Authority X (PSA X) proudly supported the official launch of the eGovPH App and the eLGU Kickoff, paving the way for more accessible and efficient government services. The event marks an important step in empowering Filipino citizens by bringing government services closer to their fingertips.

This collaboration between the PSA and the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) ensures that the Filipino people can easily access vital government services without the need to visit physical offices. By embracing digital transformation, we are not only improving the efficiency of public service delivery but also helping bridge gaps in financial inclusion and enabling smoother transactions across various sectors.

The eGovPH App and the eLGU program are key components of the government's vision for a more modernized, tech-savvy Philippines, where every Filipino can benefit from the convenience and security of digital services.

Anyone registered to the National ID system can access and view their Digital National ID via https://national-id.gov.ph or download the eGovPH app, which requires input of demographic information and facial verification to confirm the individual's identity.

For authentication of Filipinos registered to the National ID System, the PSA and DICT also developed the National ID eVerify (https://everify.gov.ph/) for government agencies and private establishments.

The National ID eVerify also has a feature called the National ID Check. This is a simple, efficient, and secure way to verify the authenticity of any format of the National ID, including the Digital National ID, by scanning the QR code feature. It is also accessible via National ID eVerify (https://everify.gov.ph/check).

Over 92 million Filipinos who have registered to the National ID are now capable of accessing their Digital National ID online and be verified through stronger authentication platforms such as the National ID eVerify and National ID Check.

Achievements in National ID Registration

In the spirit of Civil Registration Month (CRM) in February 2025, PSA X worked tirelessly to increase awareness and facilitate National ID registration, reaching a broad range of citizens, including vulnerable populations.

Throughout the month, Step-2 registration reached over 21,071 and issued more than 7,853 National ID in Paper Forms. A key initiative during February was the ongoing effort to register young children, with a strong focus on those aged 0-4 years, as well as integrating National ID registration into the services provided by the Department of Social Welfare and Development ĎSWD, Our collaboration particularly in the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps), allowed us to efficiently reach beneficiaries during their Family Development Sessions (FDS), ensuring that they could receive their National IDs alongside essential social services.

Our commitment to accessibility and efficiency was further demonstrated through various outreach activities, including information drives and registration booths set up at public events. These efforts led to a notable increase in registrations, reflecting the support and trust of local stakeholders and the public.
